## Features of "e-Navigator"




1. Provide information on **around 6000 local programmes**, including programmes from JUPAS, Information Portal for Accredited Post-secondary Programmes (iPASS), Diploma of Applied Education and Qualifications Register for timely search
2. Provide **JUPAS admission scores of last year** on different programmes for reference
3. Provide **hyperlinks to the official website of various institutions/programmes**
4. **Update** programme information **regularly**
5. Allow programme-searching by inputting the HKDSE exam results in comparison to the minimum entrance requirements
6. Allow **saving** of search record for future reference


