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HKDSE


- Since the inception of the HKDSE in 2012, it has been an important credential for senior secondary students aiming to pursue their further studies locally or abroad, or to embark on a career.
- Nearly 900,000 candidates entered the HKDSE over the years, including 55,000 candidates in the 2025 HKDSE.






The Edge of the HKDSE

- Hong Kong's unique characteristics of multilingualism and inclusiveness
- Taking the examinations in Chinese (Traditional or Simplified Chinese) or in English
- Providing a wide-ranging, balanced, flexible, and diversified curriculum that includes both academic subjects and Applied Learning subjects, as well as Other Languages subjects, to meet the diverse needs and interests of candidates (including non-Chinese and non-local candidates)





HKDSE Certificate (Category A and B Subjects)

At least one subject achieved:

Level 1 or above Category A subject

Attained or above Category B subject

* Starting from the 2025 HKDSE, Candidates' Category C subject results will be reported on the HKDSE certificate separately.



The Reporting System - Category A Subjects

Performance of candidates in Category A subjects is reported in five levels*

5 Level 5 is the highest level. Candidates with the best performance in level 5 will be awarded 5*, the next top level 5 candidates will be awarded 5*


Candidates who are not able to attain level 1 will be labeled as 'Unclassified'


*The results of Citizenship and Social Development are reported in one level: Attained

Standards-referenced Reporting system:

- Candidates' levels are reported with reference to a set of explicit and fixed standards of performance
- Level Descriptors and exemplars are provided to indicate standards required for each level
- Facilitate tertiary institutions and employers to set appropriate entrance/ job requirements







Category C (Other Languages) Subjects: New Exam Arrangements for 2025 HKDSE and Beyond

- Candidates have to take the stipulated language examinations administered in Hong Kong by the official organisations
- Candidates will have to enroll directly with the administrators of the stipulated language examinations and opt for the respective Category C subject during HKDSE registration
- Candidates' results obtained in these examinations at the stipulated proficiency level or above will be included in the HKDSE Category C results
- Candidates may take the language examinations more than once within the two years
 preceding the HKDSE they sit (for example, for the 2025 HKDSE, candidates may take
 the language examinations in 2023 and 2024, and should complete the examinations by
 the end of 2024)

Category A: School-based Assessment (SBA)

- Assessments administered in schools and marked by the students' own teachers
- SBA scores awarded will count towards students' public assessment results

Advantages]

Helps students understand their strengths and weaknesses through quality feedback from teachers Emphasises the assessment of a wide range of abilities and offers a comprehensive appraisal of students' performance Reduces dependence on the results of public examinations and boosts students' confidence and motivation to learn



How will fairness be ensured in SBA?

Moderate SBA marks

marking standards

submitted by different schools to iron out possible differences among schools in

Provide detailed guidelines, assessment criteria, exemplars and professional development training to help teachers become familiar with the SBA

> Majority of the assessments are conducted under close supervision of teachers

Review samples of students' work and assessment records, provide feedback to schools

Candidates may be liable to disqualification from the subject concerned or the whole of the exam, or suffer a mark or grade penalty for proven plagiarism







International Recognition — **Europe**



The Ministry of Education of Spain has admitted the recognition of the HKDSE qualification. HKDSE holders have access to over 90 Spanish universities.

Requirements: At least five subjects at levels 2 to 5**



In Austria, the HKDSE is considered as equivalent to the Austrian school leaving certificate (Matura) which allows admission for academic studies in the chosen subject area offered by 76 Austrian higher education institutions/ universities. (The admission requirements depend on programmes and universities)



In Germany, the HKDSE is considered as equivalent to the German school leaving certificate (Abitur). Candidates can apply for admission to over 300 German public universities in the subject area of their HKDSE subjects.

• Requirements: Level 3 or above in 4 core subjects and 2 elective subjects (Citizenship and Social Development: Attained)



The HKDSE qualification has been recognised by the <u>Nuffic</u> of the Netherlands, which considered the candidates have achieved a HAVO diploma for applying to 78 tertiary institutions there.

· Requirements: Level 2/Attained or above in 5 subjects (included Chinese Language and English Language)
