Features of "e-Navigator"

1. Provide information on over 7200 local programmes, including programmes from Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS), Information Portal for Accredited Post-secondary Programmes (iPASS), Diploma of Applied Education and Qualifications Register for timely search
2. Provide JUPAS admission scores of last year on different programmes for reference
3. Provide hyperlinks to the official website of various institutions/programmes
4. Update programme information regularly
5. Input the predicted or actual HKDSE Exam results to search for corresponding local programme information
6. Allow saving of search record for future reference



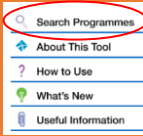

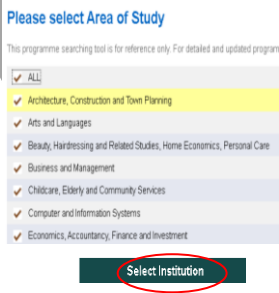
How to search programmes ?



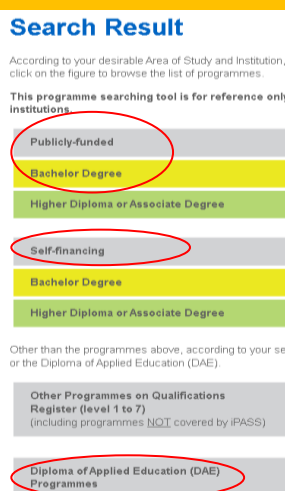
1. Click "Search Programmes" button



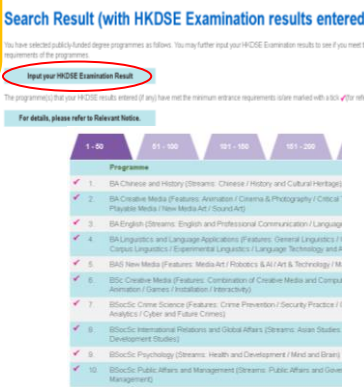
2. Select "Area of Study" and / or "Institution"



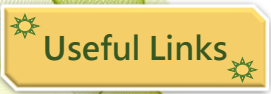
3. Select the preferred category of programmes

Frequently Asked Question 1

Question : If a candidate fails to meet the general entrance requirements in a certain core subject, will he/ she still be considered for admission to an undergraduate programme?

Answer : The "general entrance requirements (GER)" of government-funded undergraduate programmes are set at the Level of "332A" in the four core subjects (i.e. Level 3 in Chinese Language and English Language, Level 2 in Mathematics, and "Attained" in Citizenship and Social Development), plus Level 2 or 3 in two elective subjects.

Depending on the nature and needs of specific programmes, institutions may take other admission requirements into consideration in addition to the GER, such as designated/ priority subjects, total number of elective subjects and required results in specific subject(s).

The existing mechanism allows institutions to exercise flexibility in handling special admission cases. After thoroughly considering an applicant' s overall performance and subject-specific requirements, institutions may, at its discretion, admit a student who cannot meet the minimum requirements in a certain core/ elective subject, but with outstanding performance in particular subject(s) or non-academic field(s) (e.g. arts, sports or extra-curricular activities). Frequently Asked Question 2

Question : Apart from undergraduate programmes, are there any other study pathways?

Answer : There are multiple study pathways in Hong Kong. Regardless of the HKDSE exam results, Secondary 6 students may, in accordance with their own situation, formulate appropriate plans for further studies, for example, diploma programmes, associate degree programmes and higher diploma programmes, to find their way out.

Students may consult teachers and parents about different programmes' admission requirements, study pathways and prospect so as to explore different options for further studies. For information on programmes of various institutions, please refer to their websites.
