Curriculum Aims

- ▶ Why do you need to study Health Management and Social Care (HMSC)?
 - ▶ Emerging health & social care issues and concerns in Hong Kong and around the world (e.g. ageing population) are posing new challenges to youngsters. HMSC students will be better prepared to meet these challenges if they are equipped with the necessary knowledge and skills in maintaining and promoting good health and well-being.
- ▶ What will you learn from HMSC?
 - ▶ HMSC is aimed at nurturing students to become healthy and caring citizens, and contribute to building up a caring and harmonious society. Students will carry out ‘field learning’ to strengthen their problem solving skills and apply the theories learnt in classrooms.

How can the subject help you prepare for your future?

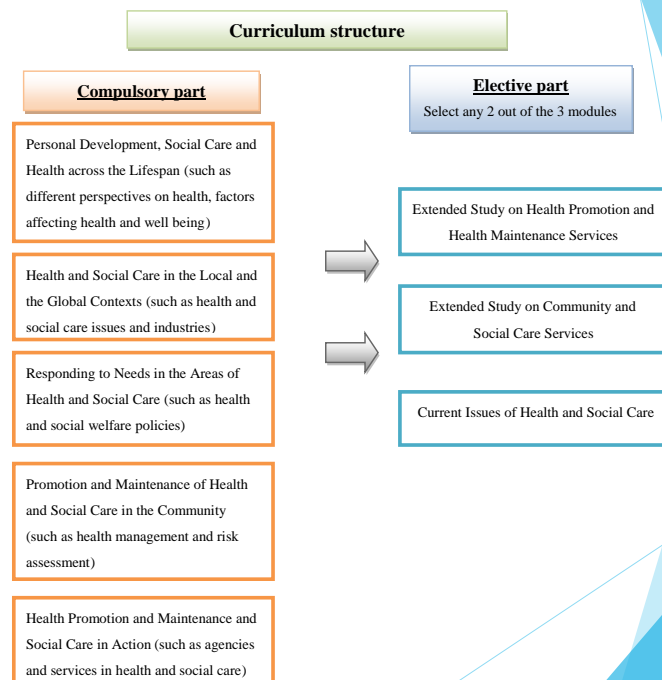
► Degree programmes related to HMSC:
